

The Information and Communication Technologies Training Centre of Getafe is a centre belonging to the General Training Directorate of the Community of Madrid (Spain).

In addition to being a public training centre providing vocational training, it is recognised as a National Reference Centre for IT Development and Communications (CRN).

The European Commission, through its National Agency (SEPIE) has granted the ERASMUS+ Accreditation 2021-2027 to our Network of Centres to carry out, among others, the "CRN Move to student mobility KA121 Project" which allows us to organise mobility grants for our students of Professional Certificates and other training specialities related to ICT.

The objectives of this project are:

- To carry out internships in companies in another European country with a specific training objective.
- To improve the professional, personal and linguistic competence of the participants.
- The participants will become real European citizens, increasing their chances of finding a job.

We are looking for companies where our students can do their internships. The project allows us to offer scholarships of 100-120 days of duration (approximately), and the company does not assume any type of expense, since according to the bases of the call:

- The management of accommodation and travel is the responsibility of the candidate, who will be supported by the Training Centre.
- The management, contracting and signing of the insurance will be carried out by our Training Centre.
- The scholarship includes a financial endowment for each participant as individual support for accommodation and transport expenses.

What requirements does the company need to host a trainee?

- A "Learning Agreement" signed by the student, the company and the Directorate General of the Community of Madrid, prior to the mobility.
- A tutor in the company to supervise their training and available in case of incidents.
